A Report on the District's Four Year Program

The MSAD#11 4 Year Program (4YP) began three years ago with one program located at the Pray Street School. The first 4YP consisted of a morning session and an afternoon session with 15 students in each session. The following year a 4YP was added for a total of two 4YP in MSAD#11. One program continued to be located at the Pray Street School and the other was located at the Pittston Consolidated School. A tracking system was developed to follow these students throughout their school years in MSAD#11. Specifically, their math and reading scores have been tracked as well as how they do overall in school.

The first 4YP class, from the 2003-2004 school year, is now in first grade. 30 students were enrolled in the 4YP that first year. 21 of those students are still attending MSAD#11's elementary schools. Their academic progress has been tracked over the last two years. The following is a breakdown of their status:
