

There is a grade range in the MSAD #11 Mastery and Grading Policy. The Mastery and Grading Policy has a conversion scale that shows ranges. Also, below are numbers that correlate directly with the E, M, PM, and DNM. These numbers are meant to be a guide and not a hard and fast rule. Left hand column – POLICY, Right hand column - GUIDANCE
